Born in Dar es Salaam in 1970, **Kambi** first started to draw because of an argument he had with his friend Gibson. They exchanged nasty caricatures of each other and fought with pen and paper for many years. By the end of primary school, they were both nominated as best artists of the school.

Kambi has no formal art training. He has acquired skills from fellow Tanzanian artists and has attended several art workshops in Dar. He paints predominantly in an abstract form using oil and acrylic on canvas or paper. He has participated in exhibitions in Tanzania, Kenya, Uganda and in 2004 he was the very first Tanzanian artist to be selected for the African Art Festival in Rome, Italy. This same year one of his artworks was chosen for the new reception building of State house, Dar es Salaam.
